

HOST FAMILIES: To apply for Rotary Youth Exchange, we require each outbound exchange student to enlist three families to host an inbound exchange student. Rotary is a true 1:1 exchange: while your son/daughter is accepted abroad, we will accept a student into our program from another country. It is the responsibility of the outbound student and his/her family to recruit host families for the inbound exchange student.

Potential host families will agree to undergo a criminal background check, a home inspection and training to host a child from another country. Hosting a foreign exchange student is a three-to-five-month commitment. The family of the outbound exchange student is often one of the families.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE? Rotary Youth Exchange is open to all qualified young people between the ages of 15 and 18. This generally includes high school sophomores and juniors. Students must be above average academically and have a spotless disciplinary record. Parents and applicants will be interviewed to determine eligibility and qualifications to be participate and be citizen ambassadors.

HOW LONG? Students exchange for a full scholastic year plus a few weeks (approximately ten months).

WHERE DO STUDENTS LIVE? Students will live with two to three volunteer host families. Living with more than one family during the year offers the exchange student a deeper and richer cultural experience.

COST: The cost varies slightly with each destination country. Some exchange partners require in-country language training, school uniforms, additional vaccinations and so on. Health insurance policies vary in cost from country to country as well. That said, the program for the 2024/25 exchange year will cost around \$6,500. Limited need-based scholarships are available.

Most destination countries also offer special additional 2-4 week trips around the country or continent. These special trips cost extra and are not included in the program fees. Scholarships are not available for these extra trips.

Rotary provides each exchange student a stipend of approximately \$75-\$100 per month of exchange to cover incidentals.
